1 Introduction

The operations described herein must be performed by persons with the training/skills required by applicable national standards and legislations (see Ch.Pt.1.2 "Personnel requirements", P. 5).

This manual must be kept intact in an easily accessible location until the product is disposed off.

1.2 Personnel requirements

Personnel performing these operations must have technical knowledge of the product acquired by at least two years of experience or by a technical training course.

1.3 Equipment required

To ensure correct assembly of the mechanical and fabric parts, and thereby to ensure that the finished product works optimally, the following equipment is required:

- · drill driver;
- · spirit level;
- · complete set of tools;
- · metal detector:
- · plumb bob;
- equipment for working at height (trestles, ladders, scaffolding, aerial platforms etc.) which meets applicable health and safety legislation.



All screws used on the aluminium components must be closed to a maximum tightening torque of 20Nm (=2Kgm). If a tightening torque greater than this is used, the castings and stainless-steel screws will be damaged. We therefore recommend using torque wrenches and drivers.



Before starting the assembly, the technician must cut the profile based on the product size (see the Assembly Manual).

2 Safety

2.1 General safety information

- Operations of assembly/installation and first use, adjustment and extraordinary maintenance must only be performed by technicians trained and specialised for those tasks, contact Technical Support.
- Do not place objects on the awning fabric.
- It is forbidden for people to hang or hold themselves on the product, this would create a serious risk of injury
 as well as potentially damaging the product itself.
- The Manufacturer shall not be held responsible for any damage resulting from either tampering or unauthorised

modification of the product.

• Wear the personal protective equipment and any other safety clothing required by health and safety legislation.

2.2 Requirements for working in safety

- The installation must be performed in full compliance with workers' health and safety legislation.
- Keep a safe distance between moving parts and any fixed obstacles (walls, terraces etc.).
- No ladders or other fixed objects must be installed or positioned near the structure such that the spaces it needed are reduced.
- Check, prior to use, that any temporary structures (trestles, scaffolding, ladders etc.) and all personal protective equipment (safety slings and harnesses etc.) meet the code and that are in good condition.
- Always use adequate personal protective equipment.
- If there is more than one installer, the work must be coordinated.
- The operators must follow the safety instructions they have received.
- If the product is to be installed above the ground-floor level of a building, the area must be cordoned off while the product is being lifted to this level to ensure nobody is beneath the suspended load.

2.3 Working environment

- Assembly and installation operations must be performed in an environment sufficiently lit by natural or artificial light (per applicable standards/legislation). The worker must have good visibility of the work to perform and must also prevent any unauthorised persons from approaching the work zone.
- Before installing any product, ensure that static, climate and planning checks have been performed to ensure the product is suitable for the installation in the chosen location.
- Also check that any necessary authorisation or planning permission has been obtained from the relevant authorities.






4 Square bar awnings hood assembly





5 Wall/ceiling awnings hood assembly




